



OSEC Red White and Blue Scramble

1. This is a scramble Tournament open to Olde Sycamore members and non-members. The cost of the event will be \$40 per person for members or non-members. \$15 of the entry fee will go to the Wounded Warrior Project. A traditional holiday fare of hot dogs, hamburgers, etc will be served at the conclusion of the event.
2. Every team will play from the white tees:
 - a. If you post a **par** the team **stays** at the same tee box the next hole.
 - b. If you post a **birdie or better**, the team **moves back** one tee box on the next hole (red to white or white to blue)
 - c. If you post a **bogey or worse**, the team **moves forward** one tee box on the next hole (blue to white or white to red)
3. All members of each team must have their drive selected **at least three (3) times** during the round. Drives include shots on par three holes. Drives will be noted on the team's scorecard.
4. When in the fairway or rough (only), the team may play the next shot from within one club length of the selected golf ball's original position – no closer to the hole. If a selected shot is played from a hazard, sand bunker, or fringe of the green, the next shot must be played from the selected ball's original position (no one club lengths relief). When in a sand bunker, the bunker may be raked after each shot.
5. Each team will have the opportunity to purchase a "surprise" package that may contain mulligans, opportunity to tee off from the 150 yard marker, string, or other opportunities as decided by the committee. The cost of the package will be \$40 per team. There will be a "pot of gold" on #17. The cost to participate is \$5 a ticket. There will also be a 50/50 raffle. Raffle tickets are \$1 apiece or 6 for \$5.



6. If all members of a team are dressed in red, white and blue, the team will be able to tee off from the red tees on their first hole.
7. Sign up as a team or sign up individually and you will be placed on a team.
8. The most important rule: **HAVE FUN!!!!**
